






Expand the economic focus of diaspora engagement beyond remittances: trade, entrepreneurship, philanthropy and tourism

Collect data to measure the economic impact

Develop tailored financial products and services for diaspora entrepreneurs

Partner with chambers of commerce / private sector



Human Capital

Promote the mutual recognition of qualifications to maximize the mobility of diaspora talent

Recognize the diverse skillsets of diaspora members

Promote long-term and multi-stakeholder networking

Digitalize knowledge transfer and skills exchange



Social Capital

Strengthen the coordination of diaspora and humanitarian responses

Encourage the development of networks and organizations

Enable diaspora to exercise their rights to multiple citizenship and voting

Strengthen the capacities of diplomatic missions



Cultural Capital

Embed cultural engagement as a central pillar of diaspora engagement policies and strategies

Recognize and celebrate the cultural contributions of diasporas

Tailor programming to the cultural interests and sensitivities (interests, age, gender...)

Institutionalize diaspora participation in policies and programmes from local to global levels

Recognize diasporas as partners in addressing social and humanitarian challenges and boosting their capacities






Dublin Declaration

"Facilitate the launch of a Global Diaspora Policy Alliance (GDPA) that will deliver an inclusive ecosystem of collaboration across governments and partners in academia, civil society and the private sector to prioritize diaspora engagement policymaking and action in countries of origin and destination. This will further recognize and include diaspora engagement across local, national, regional, and global policy agendas relating to all forms of development."
