Strengthen the coordination of diaspora and humanitarian responses

Cultural Capital

Embed cultural engagement as a central pillar of diaspora engagement policies and strategies

Recognize and celebrate the cultural contributions of diasporas

Tailor programming to the cultural interests and sensitivities (interests, age, gender...)

Institutionalize diaspora participation in policies and programmes from local to global levels

Recognize diasporas as partners in addressing social and humanitarian challenges and boosting their capacities

Strengthen the protection of the rights of migrants and access to services

Dublin Declaration

“Facilitate the launch of a Global Diaspora Policy Alliance (GDPA) that will deliver an inclusive ecosystem of collaboration across governments and partners in academia, civil society and the private sector to prioritize diaspora engagement policymaking and action in countries of origin and destination. This will further recognize and include diaspora engagement across local, national, regional, and global policy agendas relating to all forms of development.”

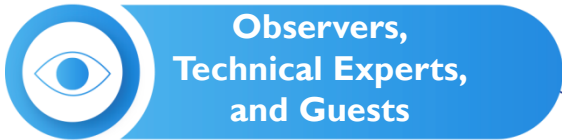
